



## Ranch Rules for Hunting and Fishing Access

- If you have not obtained a signed Release, Holdharmless and Indemnity Agreement from Pathfinder Ranches, you are not authorized for access to the deeded property. Access requests can be made to: [Access@PathfinderRanches.com](mailto:Access@PathfinderRanches.com). Please allow abundant time to process your request. Access is only granted to the person whose name appears on the Release Agreement.
- You are personally responsible to know your own location on the ranches. Not all fences are property boundaries. It is highly recommended that you utilize a GPS to ensure accurate knowledge of your whereabouts.
- **All vehicles, including ATVs, are restricted to traveling on established two-track roads only.** Do not create new roads or trails. Do not drive to your harvested animal. Please pack your animal to the established two-track road where your vehicle is at. Please do not block road access when you park your vehicle.
- No fires are allowed in any form. Please do not litter. Kudos to those who pick up other's litter.
- Do not hunt or shoot near buildings. Please do not sight in your rifles on deeded property.
- No overnight camping on deeded property. No dogs allowed on deeded property.
- Leave gates as you find them. Do not harass livestock or hunt in a manner that disturbs them.
- Access is not granted for commercial activity, including outfitting of hunters.
- If you harvest an animal on deeded land, **please turn in the landowner coupon to the red mailbox across from the Pathfinder entrance on Hwy. 220**, or mail the coupon to: Pathfinder Ranches, P.O. Box 768, Cheyenne, WY 82003.
- When an animal(s) is harvested, **please submit a photograph of the animal and the location where it was harvested** (GPS preferred) to [Access@PathfinderRanches.com](mailto:Access@PathfinderRanches.com). This information is for us to better understand the usage areas of the ranches, the details of your harvest (age, size, etc), and to celebrate in your success.
- Report any wildlife violation by calling 1-877-WGFD-TIP (877-943-3847).
- Future hunting opportunities depend on hunter compliance with all ranch rules.
